

Instructions: Installing WMM6 into Windows 7

Follow these instructions carefully. All the files are uploaded by me and are virus free.

1) Run the Movie Maker Setup program. It will install Vista's Windows Movie Maker 6.0 (not the crappy 2.6 warm-over from Windows XP) onto Windows 7. WMM6 was maybe the best thing to come out of Vista, and the main reason I switched to Vista from XP!

2) To get the HD publishing options, copy the folder "Profiles" to the Movie Maker directory. It's either C:\Program Files\Movie Maker\Shared\ [for Windows 7 x32] OR C:\Program Files (x86)\Movie Maker\Shared\ [if you have Windows 7 x64]. If you already have a Profile folder inside the Shared folder, just copy the 4 HD files into your existing Profiles folder.

The final result should look like this:

C:\Program Files\Movie Maker\Shared\Profiles [for Windows7 32-bit]

OR

C:\Program Files (x86)\Movie Maker\Shared\Profiles [for Windows7 64-bit]

There should be 4 HD .prx files inside "Profiles".

3) Done. Now you can run the program from your start menu and have the same Windows Movie Maker 6.0 you had in Vista with all the HD publishing options (via Vista Ultimate). The HD profiles will show up under Edit/Publish Movie/This Computer. Enjoy!

Be aware that you can't publish directly to the Windows 7 DVD Maker. It's made strictly for that wretched Windows Live Movie Maker. You'll have to save your movie as a high quality WMV file first. If you don't like it, complain directly to Microsoft at:
